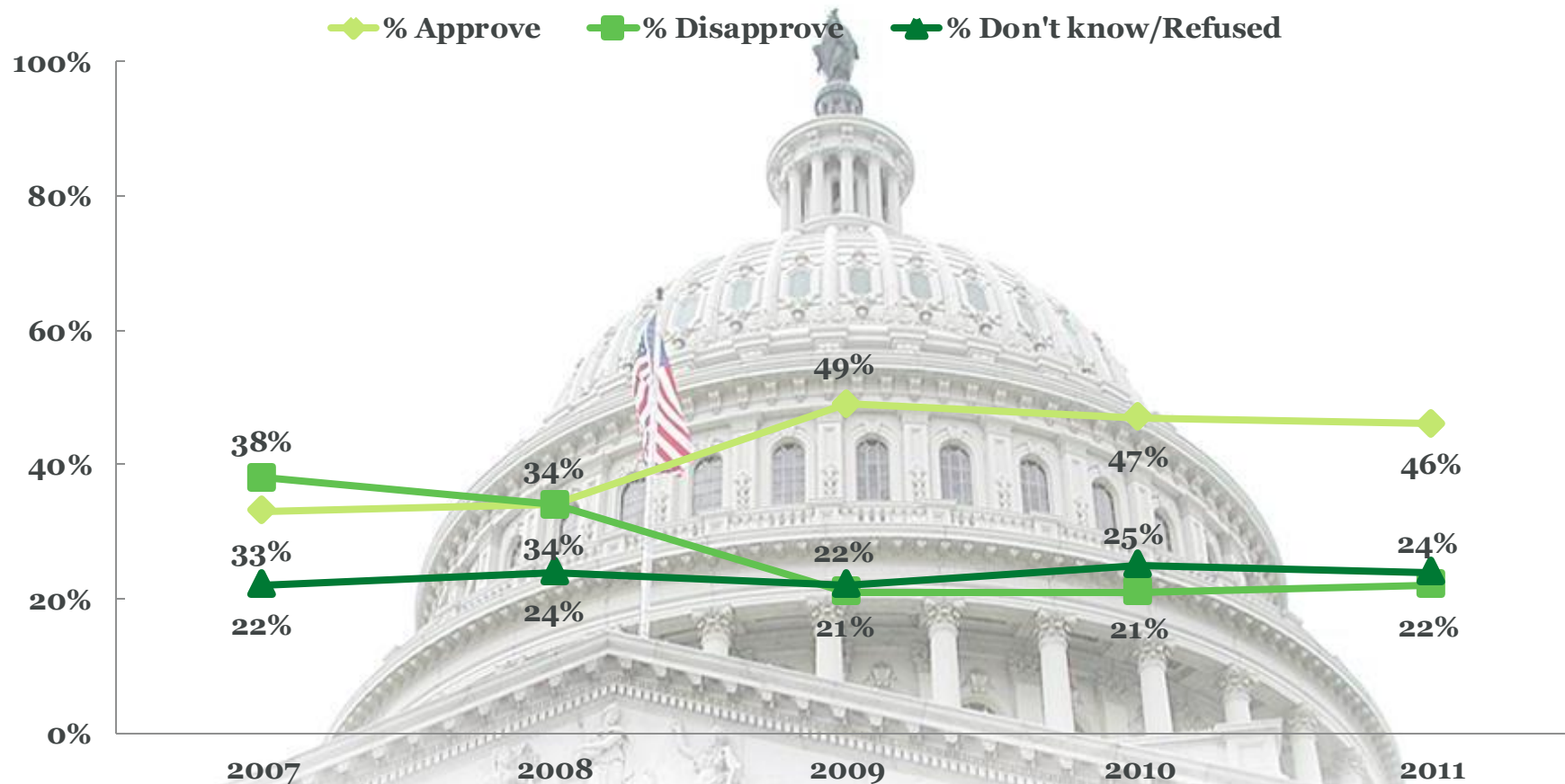

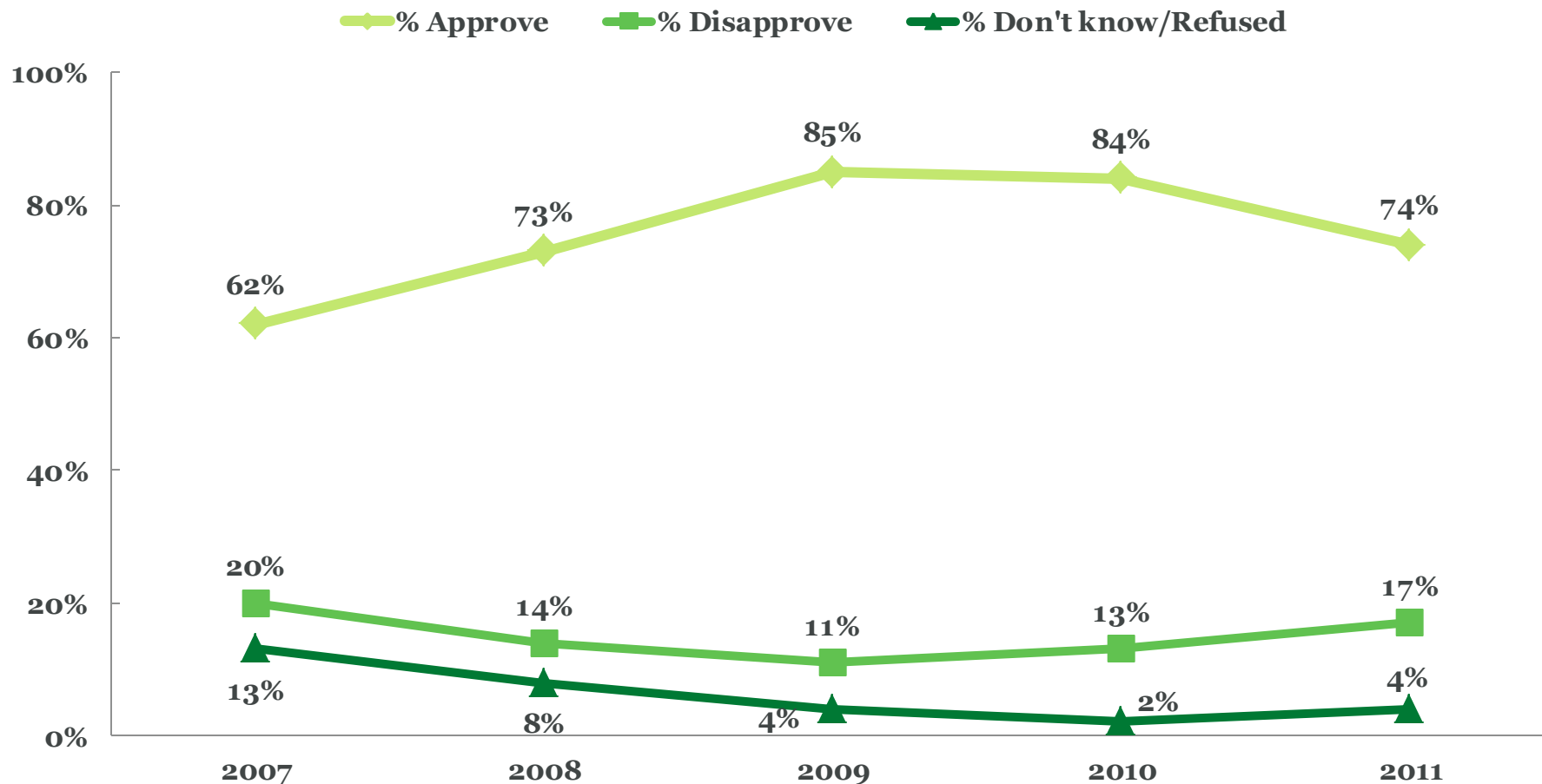

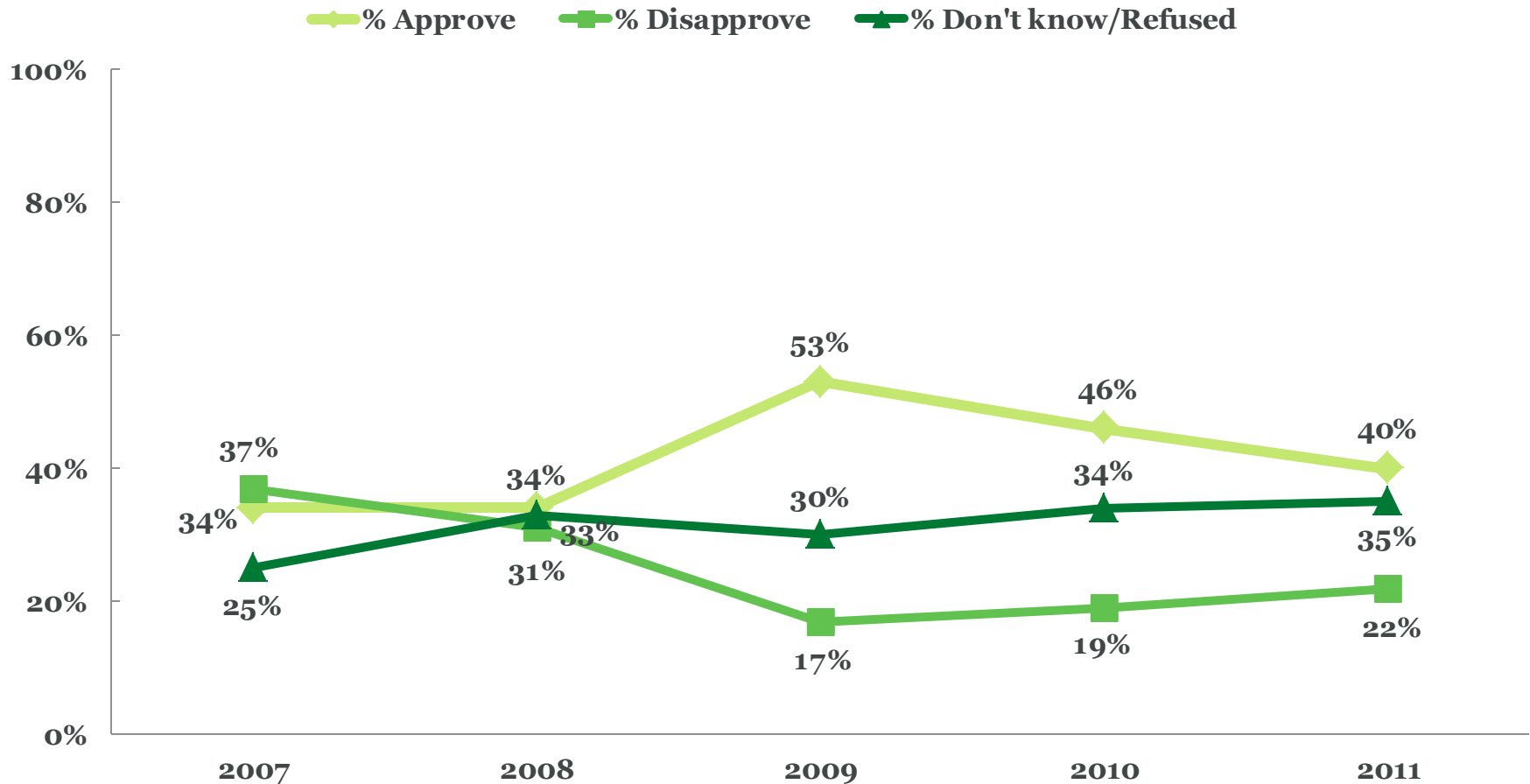

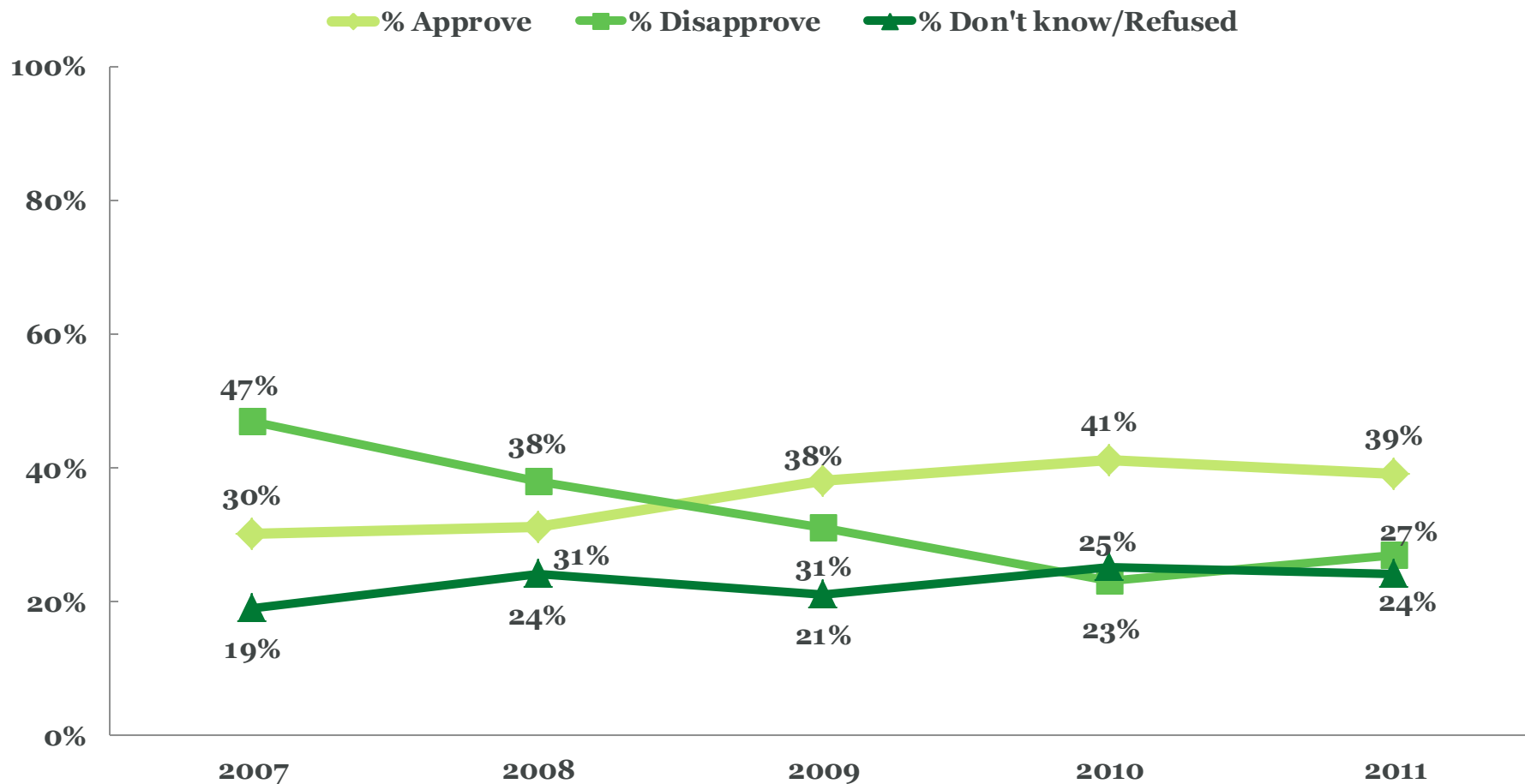

Views of U.S. Leadership: Americas



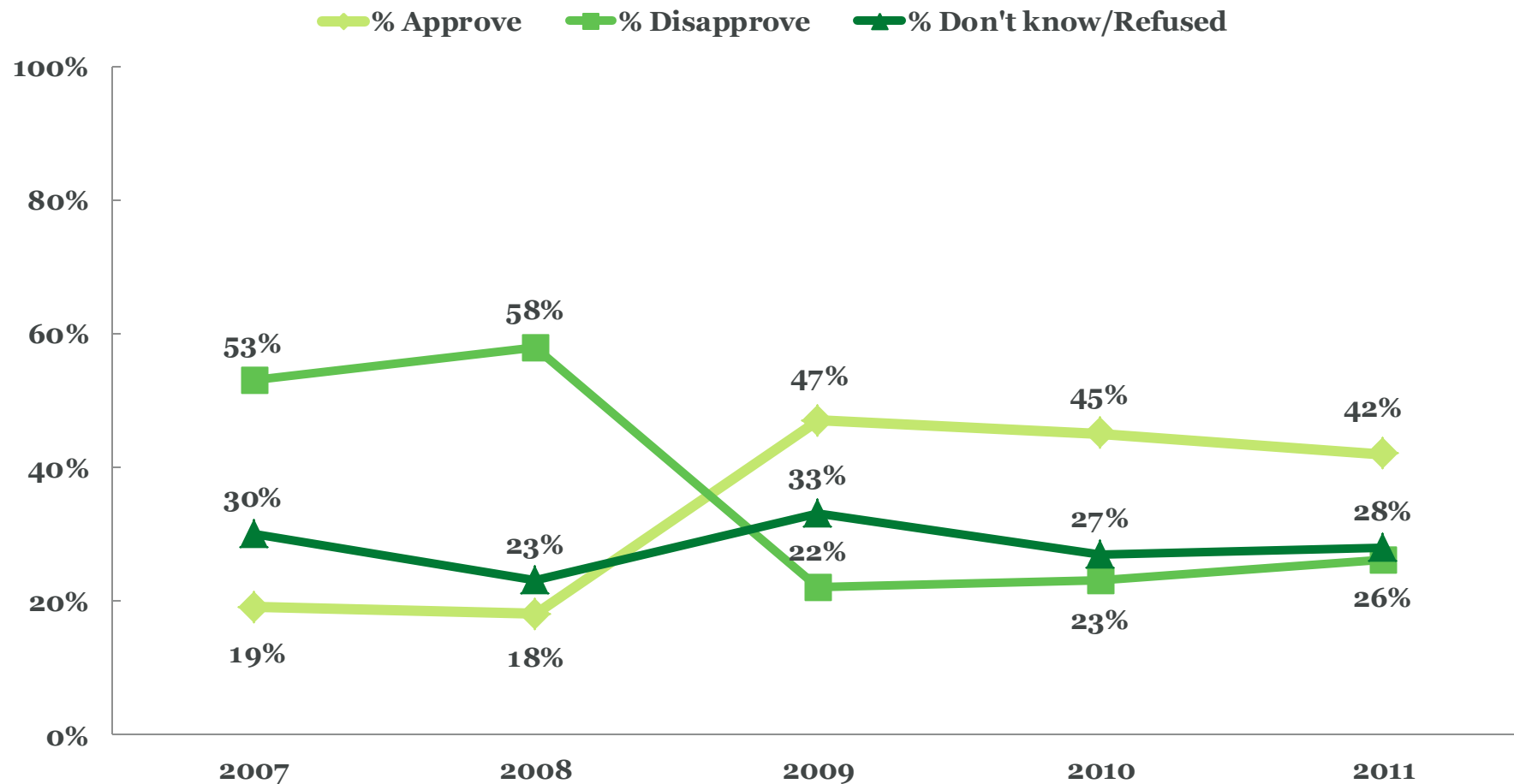

Views of U.S. Leadership: Asia



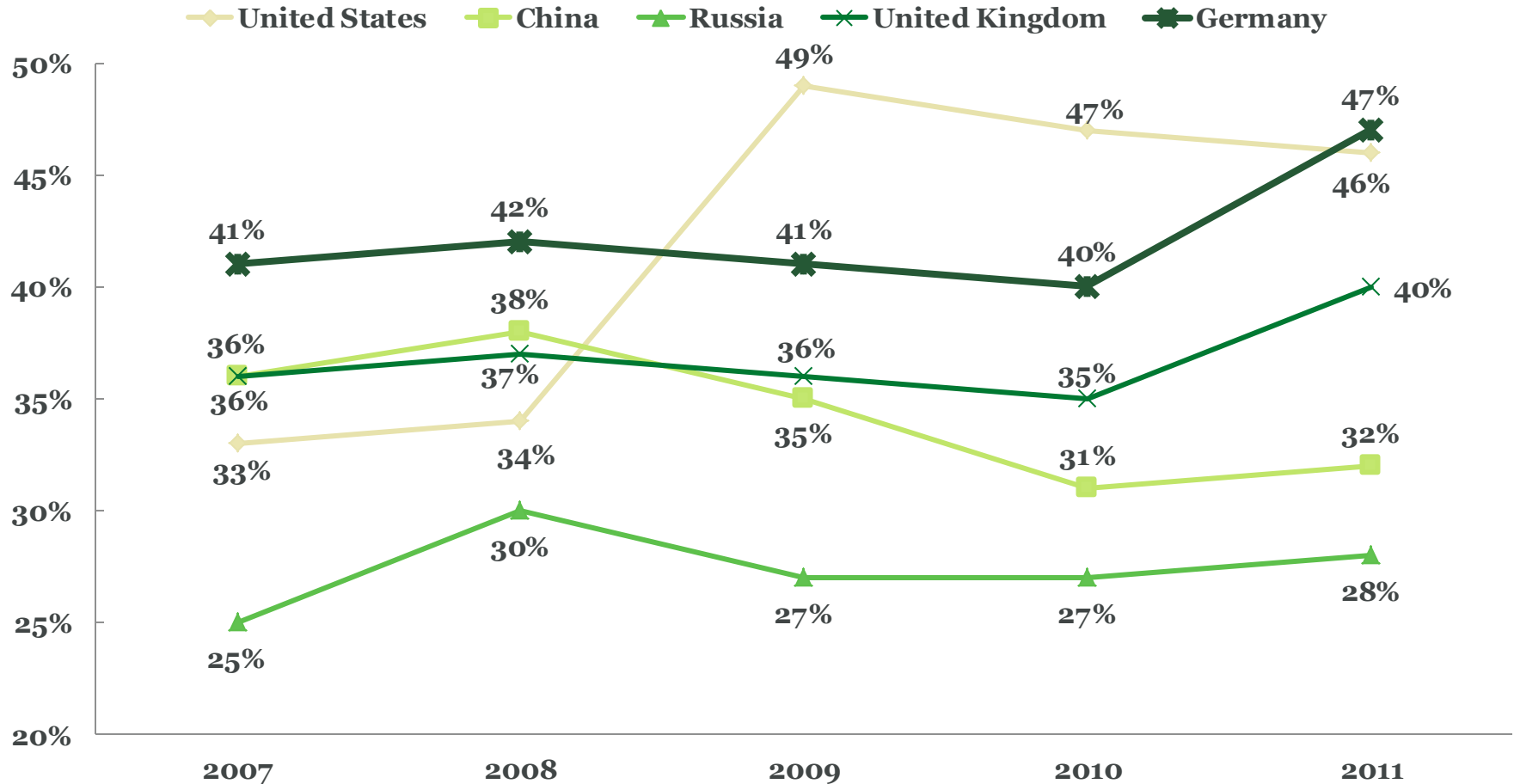

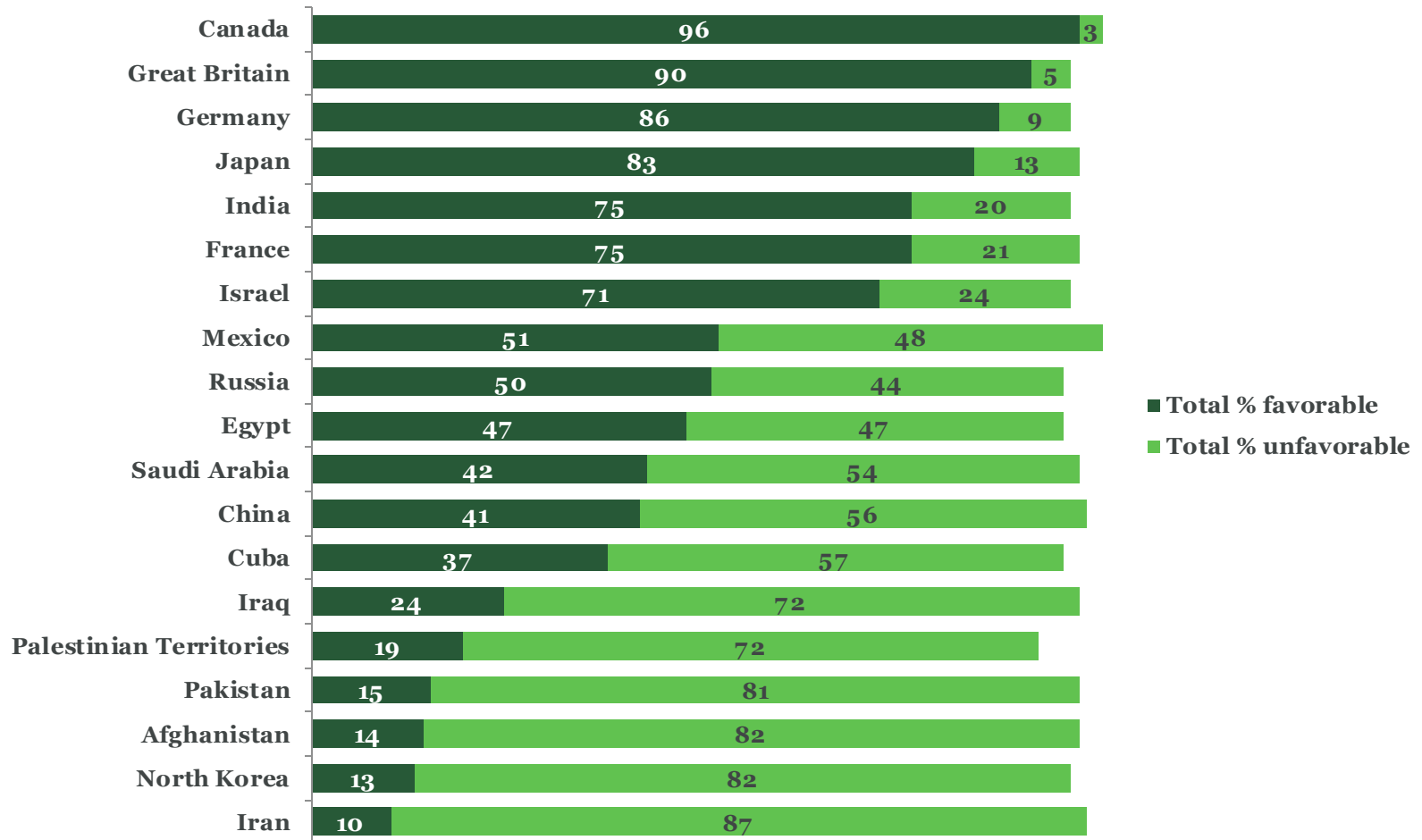

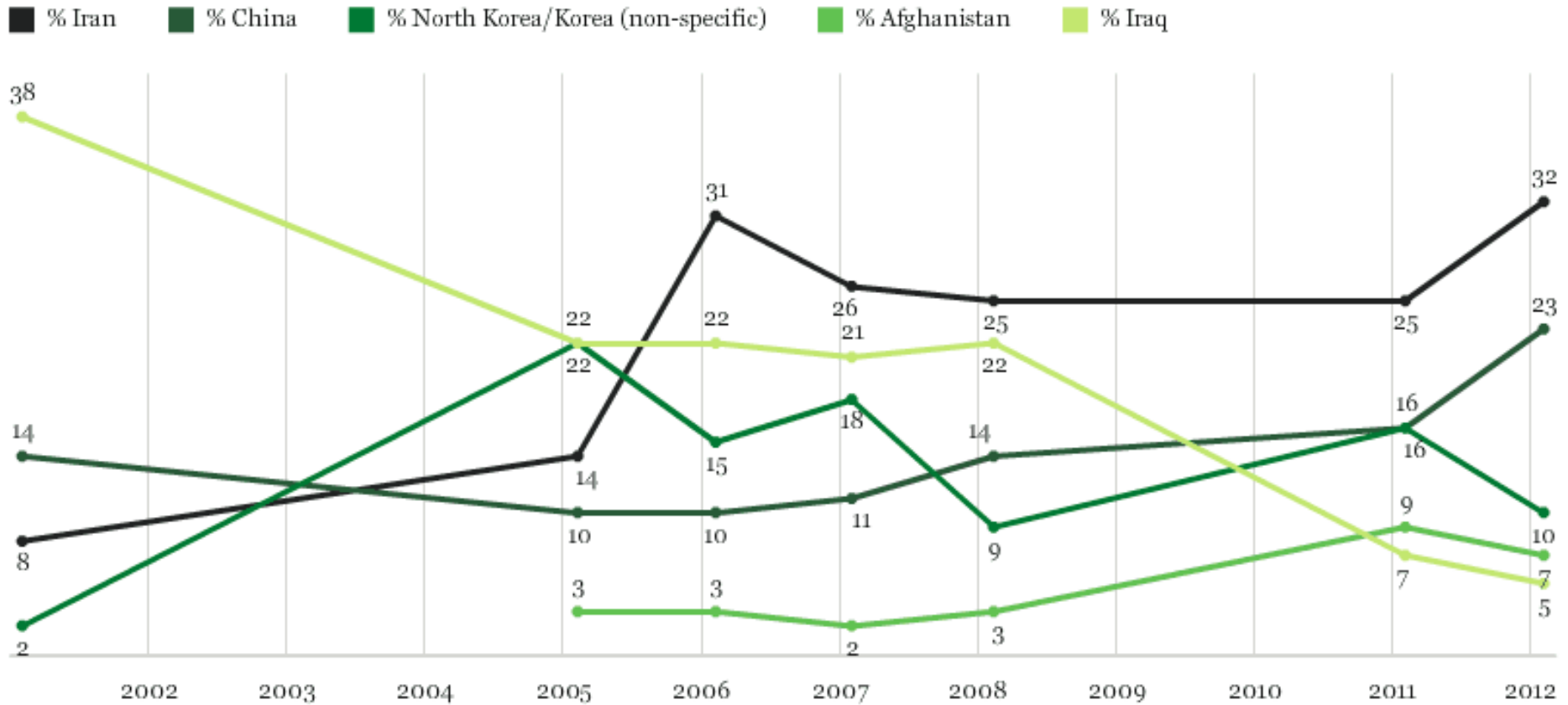

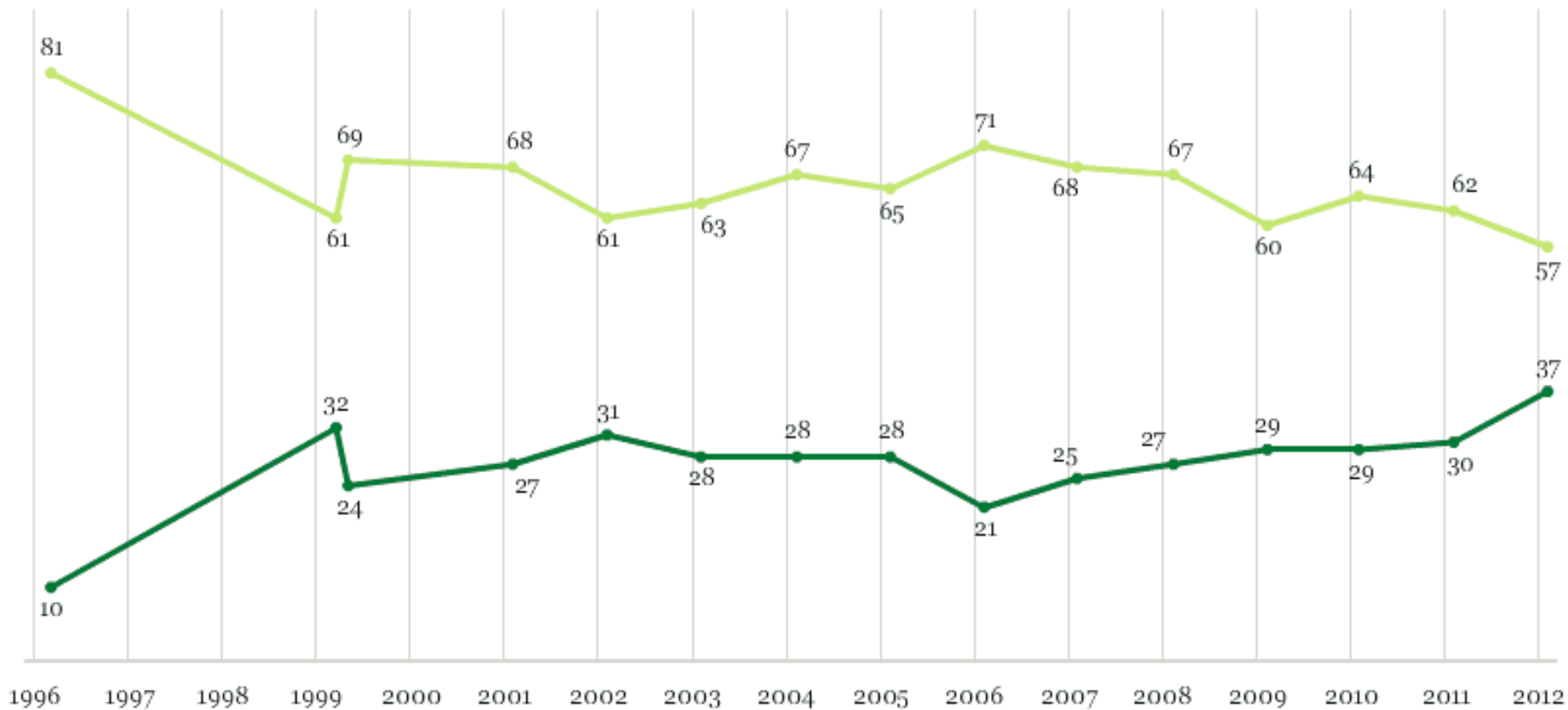

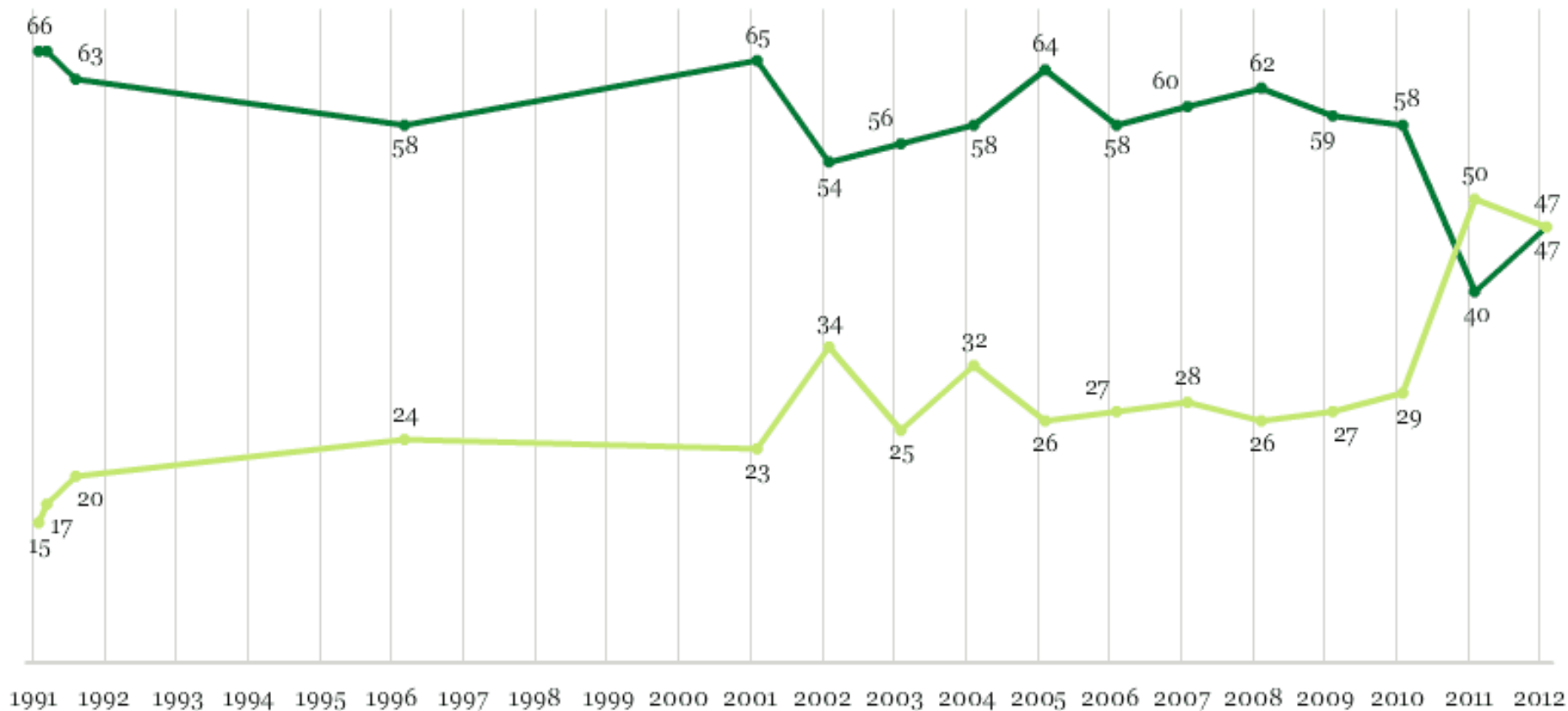

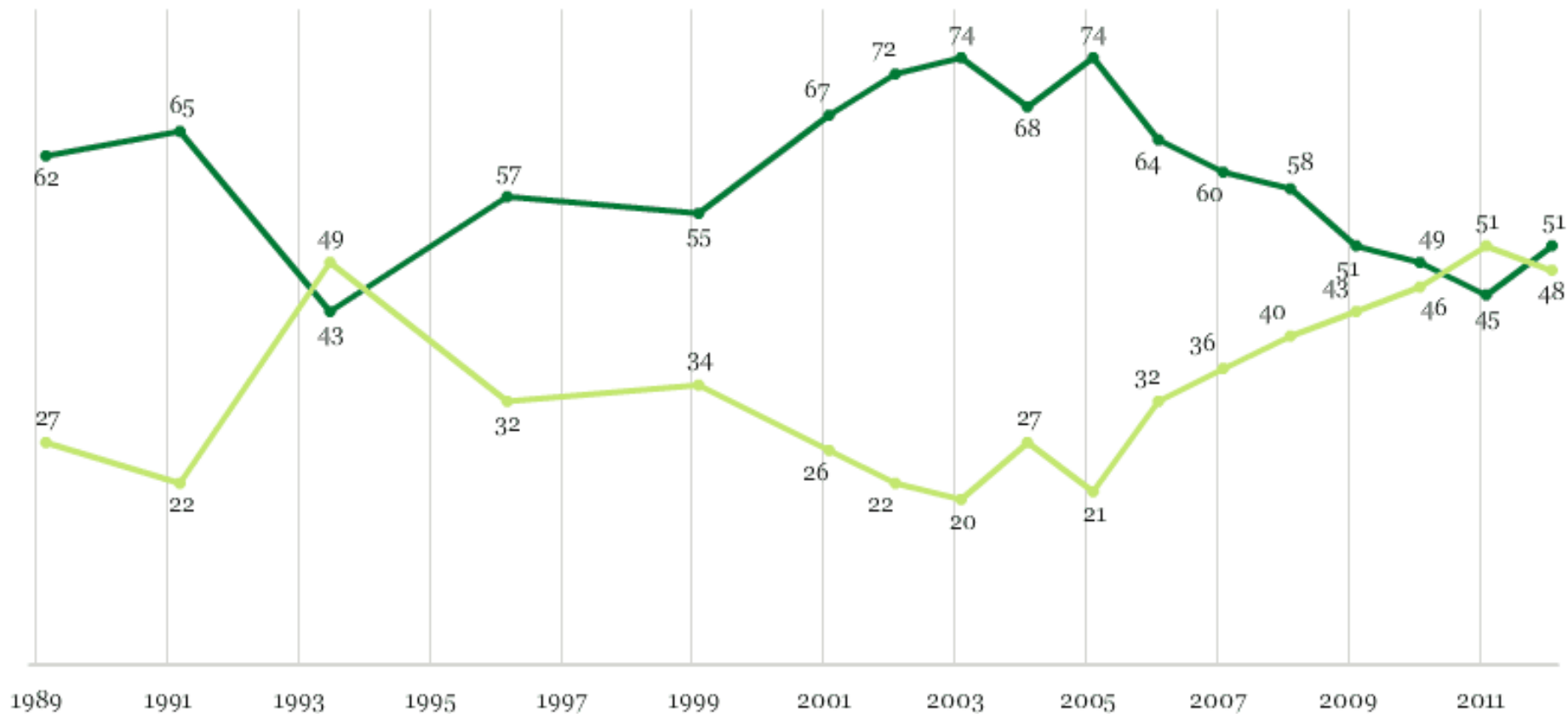

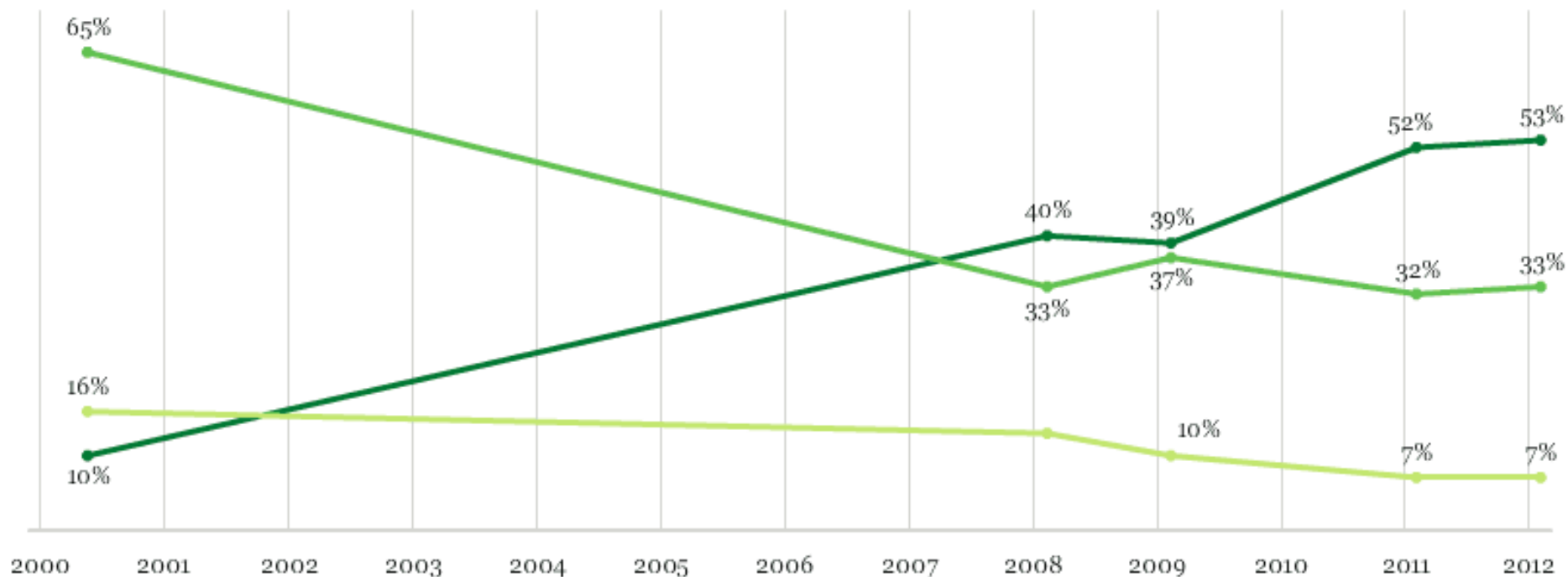
