## Norway Interviewer Instructions

We are trying to determine how common it is for a respondent to not have an opinion (or not want to share it) but upon probing, provide an answer. We want to see which items are probed most often — and IF people change their “don’t know/refused” answer, what do they tend to change it to?

For this wave, please indicate the item was probed (check the box or click the button) if the respondent indicated “don’t know” (e.g., did not have an answer) or “refused” (e.g., did not WANT to answer and you probed for an answer). Please indicate when you probe regardless of the outcome (it’s OK if the respondent’s answer does not change; still mark it as probed).

Please do NOT mark as probed if the respondent did not hear the question, or simply gave the incorrect answer and needed to be reminded of the scale (e.g., for a yes/no item, the respondent says “approve”). If you can’t tell if a respondent is just asking for a re-read of the item or indicating they don’t have an opinion, just use your best judgment.

Remember to probe all “don’t know” and “refused” responses once (with the exception of the items on ISIS and al-Qaeda).

Country Would Move to	To which country would you like to move?	20.5
